

Dear Senator Dole:

On behalf of the New Hampshire residents, with or without disabilities, who support this organization, we write to urge you to schedule S.652 (Pressler), the telecommunications Competition and Deregulation Act, for a Senate floor vote at the earliest opportunity.

In 1991,1992, 1993, and 1994, the telecommunication legislation failed in the Schate and/or in the House. We do not want to take the chance that 1995 repeats those failures.

Thanks largely to your personal leadership on the bill, S.652 is a comprehensive bill that provides important advances for people with disabilities. It requires ALL equipment manufacturers and ALL information service providers to make their offerings accessible to and uscable by Americans with disabilities.

In addition, S.652 spurs competition across the communications industry. This competition should bring lower prices for consumers. Thus, S.652 promises accessible and affordable communications.

We urge you to accelerate Senate consideration of this very important bill and we thank you for your help,
